North Georgia Falcons Football Eligibility Form

The rules of eligibility of the NG Falcons apply to all players who desire to play for NGF. You are being asked to read these rules and sign your name at the bottom of the page stating that you, the player, and you, a parent or guardian of the player, acknowledge that the player meets these eligibility requirements. If you do not meet all eligibility requirements, then you cannot play in the NGF.

Boys, that meet all High School eligibility requirements, are eligible to play in the games. Girls are not eligible to play.

Boys must not turn nineteen (19) years of age prior to <u>September 1st of the football season.</u> Boys must be homeschooled or attending a homeschool co-op (such as schools that reside in churches or meet in other building structures) or attend a Christian School, private school, public school or online school.

Boys who have graduated or received a GED, from a public, private, Christian, Co-op, or Homeschool, are ineligible. Any boy, who participates in a graduation ceremony but does not receive a diploma, must notify the NGF office in writing.

Any boy who has used up his four (4) year high school playing eligibility will not be allowed to play on the NGF. If an individual from a public, private or Christian School is fourteen (14) years of age or older and wishes to play, must submit a transcript and proof of eligibility. The office will determine the individual's status.

A boy who turn fifteen (15) prior to **September 1st** will be considered a freshman. This will determine his eligibility from this point forward. Any boy who transfers from a public, private or Christian School will be eligible based on his transcript year.

Boys, who desire to play for the NGF, must be living at home under the authority of their parents or legal guardian. If living with a legal guardian, then proof of guardianship must be submitted along with the boy's eligibility paperwork.

Boys transferring from public, private or Christian schools and wish to play in the NGF, must provide proof of homeschooling by submitting their "INTENT TO HOME SCHOOL" letter which is required by the State of Georgia or a transcript from his former school.

Adding players to a team roster after the initial start of the NGF season will be allowed until the last game of the regular season. Before a boy is allowed to play in any NGF games, all required paperwork must be submitted and approved by the NGF office. Player approval will be made by the NGF office within 48 business hours.

Joint enrolled students will be allowed to participate, in the GFC, under the State of Georgia joint enrollment ruling while taking high school courses at home or a home school co-op or other approved school. The player must show proof of his "joint-enrolled" status by submitting to the NGF office a letter from the college that he is attending as a joint enrolled student.
